FOUR-BALL RULES - FOUR PERSON INDIVIDUAL & TEAM

- 1. Each group of four plays their own ball.
- 2. At the end of the hole, mark everyone's score.
- 3. Individual scores are added as per standard golf rules. Handicaps will be calculated by the course "Callaway style" at the end of play.
- 4. Team score is the total of the lowest two scores.
- 5. No scores greater than double bogey to maintain speed of play.
- 6. Men tee off from the "White or middle" tees and the women from the "Red or forward tees".
- 7. Please turn in scorecards to the Starter or Tournament Director.
- 8. If your team has only three players, one player may play an extra shot. Please keep up with the group in front of you.
- 9. Prizes will be awarded at the Happy Hour awards reception after all players complete their round. Prizes include top team score, Individual (gross) and Individual (net).

GOLF ETIQUETTE:

- 1. Please observe all local course rules.
- 2. Leave the putting green as soon as you have holed out.
- 3. Do not play until the players in front of you are out of range.
- 4. Please rake all marks made in the sand bunkers.
- 5. Enjoy the day and have fun!

CONTESTS:

- 1. Closest to the Pin: If your tee shot is on the green and closest to the pin/hole, write your name on the marker card and place the marker in the ground on the spot or along the side of the green.
 - Today's CTP holes are holes #3, #8, and #11
- Longest Drive (Men and Women): If your drive is in the fairway and the longest, write your name on the marker card and place the marker in the ground next to the spot where your ball lies.
 Today's Longest Drives hole is #9

COVID-19:
