


A Unique Geologic Hazard Disrupts Critical Lifelines

- Mud pots and mud volcanoes are common features at the southern end of the San Andreas Fault near the Salton Sea.
- These features are stationary and relatively benign with the sole exception of a mud pot that moved over 500 feet in the past five years.
- Termed the "Niland Mud Geyser," this unique phenomenon ripped through a transcontinental railroad, oil pipeline, and a state highway.
- The presentation will focus on the emergency response to maintain the railroad and pipeline operations.
