### MOSQUITO BRIDGE SITE TOUR - FINAL CHANCE TO SEE THE EXPOSED GEOTECHNICAL WORK

Built in 1939, the original, but long functionally obsolete, Mosquito Bridge is being converted to a bicycle and pedestrian bridge and being replaced by a 1,180 linear foot cantilever segmental bridge that will tower more than 300 feet above the South Fork American River gorge, a vision first initiated in 1993 and now being realized through enhanced design and technologies with a project completion date of 2025.

Two CalGeo groups visited the site in June 2023 to see geotechnical and foundation work in progress, and we are now going back to see the final stages of that stage before they start pier column construction in February. El Dorado County Senior Civil Engineers Brian Franklin, PE, Resident Engineer, and Aradhana Kochar, PE, Structure Representative, will provide an design update presentation at the field office and then lead a tour of the sitework being managed by the Prime Contractor, Shimmick Construction.
