




Q1: Where is your primary base of operations




Q2: What percentage of your workforce is now working from home?




Q3: Have you laid off any staff?




Q4: Have you applied, or plan to apply for the SBA loan paycheck protection program (PPP)?




Q5: If you applied, have you received a loan?




Q6: Are you considering using the EDD Work share Program?




Q7: What percentage of staff are you considering for the EDD work share program?




Q8: Have you reduced hours or payroll for staff compared to 8 weeks ago?




Q9: What percentage have you reduced hours or payroll?




Q10: Are you providing any extra extended sick leave to employees beyond typical PTO that have quarantined due to Covid-19




Q11: What percentage of your projects have been shut down or are on-hold?




Q12: By what percentage have you reduced work hours due to projects being on hold due to shelter in place orders?




Q13: What percentage of your workload is in the FIELD currently?




Q14: Are you providing face coverings or masks for employees?




Q15: How has your company's workload changed for April 2020? Enter as a percentage compared to April 2019 (50% = decreased by half, 100% = same, 200% = double)
