Every year our student chapter participates in the ASCE Pacific Southwest Conference (PSWC) in the Geotechnical category. We would like to request your financial support as we begin our work for the 2020-2021 competition held this spring at the University of California, Los Angeles.

This Geotechnical competition invites students to design and construct a model mechanically stabilized earth (MSE) retaining wall using paper reinforcement taped to a poster board wall facing (named Geo Wall). The goal is to hold a soil backfill of over 500 lbs. using the least amount of reinforcement, without failing. This student led competition provides project management, design, and budgeting skills, and an experience essential to a well-rounded engineering education.

CSUN will compete against some of the most prestigious universities in the pacific southwest, including UCLA, USC, Cal Poly San Luis Obispo, University of Hawaii, and Northern Arizona University to name just a few of the 16+ schools. CSUN's Geo Wall Team has solidified their place as a top competitor placing 1st in the regional competition and 10th at the national conference hosted by the ASCE Geotechnical Institute. We are continuing to build on this previous success and are developing solutions that will allow us to become the premier geotechnical team in the nation. We intend to attend the national GI conference once again this April in Indiana Wells, CA and need your help to achieve our goals.
